Methods of Payment:

Etransfer: order@al-anonbookstore.ca (no security question required)

This is the **Preferred Method** of payment so the bookstore receives the full amount of the payment without any service charges. Orders placed via the webstore can be tagged "Pay at Store" and the amount e-transferred afterward.
