

A Message from Our AIS Chair

Thank you to all of the Calgary Al-Anon and Al-Anon Information Services community for your support over the past three years. You have made it easy and rewarding to fulfill this role. Rotation of leadership is an important Al-Anon principle and one that I respect. I am stepping away from this position, but staying available for support of the new AIS chairperson.

When I review the Chairperson job description, I find that I have nothing to add. It is a coordinating role that highlights the importance of good communication between the rest of the AIS committee and the Calgary Al-Anon community as a whole. My one deficit in this role is in the area of utilizing support and participation with the World Service e-community. Hopefully, the new chairperson will have skills in this direction that I did not.

Since my last report, I have continued to monitor the Calgary AIS electronic mailbox and answer correspondence promptly. The number of messages asking for meeting list information has decreased. This may be due to the new monitoring system and the message, directing the caller to meeting list information. Otherwise, this responsibility has been about forwarding people and questions in the right direction.

The Calgary AIS Public Outreach Coordinator team and the Chairperson have supported the Area Public Outreach Coordinator and committee with the current initiative: a poster blitz is planned for September during Recovery Week. We have also been in discussions about future plans for Area 80 Public Outreach initiatives.

It has been rewarding during my term to connect with the Edmonton AIS committee as well as contacts with Red Deer and Lethbridge. I see communication and support for all areas of Alberta/N.W.T. Area 80 as improving and committed to continuing that level of communication and mutual support.

We have accomplished many improvements in our efforts to serve the Calgary Al-Anon community:


