



AIS Treasurer's Report

A big (almost summertime!) thank you to all the wonderful Al-Anon groups who continue to generously and kindly support AIS. At our meeting on June 2 we unanimously voted to continue our support for the bookstore and also Area 78 by donating \$1,000 to each. In addition we are holding \$750 in reserve for AlAteen if and when needed.

This will help us reduce our bank balance from the current \$4700 downwards to a prudent reserve of \$1500. We also have a few expenses for Area Assembly, a budgeted reserve for Public Outreach and some administrative expenses which will take us closer to the targeted balance of \$1500.

But do keep the donations coming, as they enable the entire Al-Anon fellowship at the local, area, national and world service levels "continue to be the dynamic and forward looking organization it is".

For me personally, Al-Anon has been a life saver and a life changer - let us all keep up the good service work - with an attitude of gratitude and not obligation.
