



#### Public Outreach Just Got Easier!

People need to hear about Al-Anon, so ideas to make it easy are always welcome. A guest speaker from Omaha, NE recently made a suggestion at our Public Outreach (PO) meeting, and it is now available here in Alberta/N.W.T. as well.

Rather than each Group gathering pamphlets for public events, they can now simply contact the PO Coordinator (Ric Z.), and he ships a *Public Outreach Kit* with all needed CAL materials and even an Al-Anon tablecloth. Afterward, the Group simply replaces the pamphlets given away (or makes a donation to PO for them) and returns the kit. And shipping is very affordable.

Here's an update from a Group that tried the new kit:

"At the suggestion of one of our group members, and after a group conscience, Westside AFG decided to set out Al Anon literature and information at the annual pancake breakfast held by the church that hosts our weekly meetings.

For reasons of anonymity we decided not to have anyone "man" the table. We did have some concerns about people making assumptions that Al-Anon is affiliated with the church.

Our Group Rep reached out to Ric who handles Public Outreach and we came up with a plan to get public outreach materials to the event. That process was efficient and smooth!

We did have two members at the pancake breakfast, though not minding the table. They indicated that people picked up pamphlets and stopped to scan the bar codes. According to the event organizers, there were over 600 people at the pancake breakfast, many of them community members that are not members of the church.

From my inventory after the event, I learned that not much literature was taken. The pamphlets that did get picked up include:

8 copies of Alcoholism, The Family Disease 4 copies of Detachment 6 copies of Information for the Newcomer

Now that we know the public outreach materials that are available and how to access them, we will be alert to other outreach opportunities in our community.

\*Note: Our group purchased a few additional pamphlets to keep on hand for newcomers and for our members to distribute to doctor's offices etc.
